

How to properly clean the glass of my stove



During use, the glass of your stove or fireplace can quickly turn black, preventing you from fully enjoying the beauty of the flame. Here are our 3 recommendations to enjoy a perfect view of the flames!

With a glass cleaner

Specific products exist for the cleaning of the glass of your fireplace, these last ones are especially conceived to allow a fast and effective elimination of soot and tar deposited against the glass.

We recommend Magic Feu products, because they are made in an environmentally responsible way and are among the most effective. In addition, they are easy to use:

1. Apply the product to a cloth/cleaning paper
2. Clean the glass (it can be warm, but not hot)
3. Start again if it is not enough to obtain a clean window. If this product is not powerful enough, there is also the glass stripper which is more powerful

Cleaning with ash

This grandmotherly technique works surprisingly well on wood stoves. The stove must be cold before you start cleaning.

1. Take a rag and dampen it with water
2. Dip one corner of the cloth into fine ash taken directly from the ash pan of your stove
3. Apply the water + ash mixture directly to the glass
4. Use a damp cloth to clean up any residual traces
